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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. The Temporary Disaster Debris Site, DS 29-005 was activated by the City of Thomasville on 3/20/14 for vegetative debris storage and processing as a result of the March 6-7, 2014 storm event.
2. The collection of storm debris for the City of Thomasville has been completed. Approximately 27,000 cubic yards of debris was received at this site.
3. The city has contracted with DRC for processing of the storm debris, and grinding of the vegetative debris for mulch is currently ongoing.
4. The processed mulch is to be utilized by the City of Thomasville and hauled to end-users.
5. Activities at the site observed to be in accordance with Temporary Disaster Debris Site requirements.
